b) Of your / juristic person monthly / weekly income and expenditure, supported by documentary proof inclusive of a statement by your employer giving full particulars of your emoluments and in the case of a juristic person, the latest financial statements.

Notice:

If the court is satisfied on the grounds of sufficient proof or otherwise -

- a) That you have knowledge of a notice referred to in section 65A (1) of the Act and that you have failed to appear before the court on the date and at the time specified in the notice, or  
b) That you, where the proceedings were postponed in your presence to a date and time determined by the court, have failed to appear before on that date and at that time; or  
c) That you failed to remain in attendance at the proceedings or at the proceedings so postponed.

The court may, at the request of the judgement creditor or his or her attorney, authorize the issue of a warrant directing the sheriff to arrest you and bring you before a competent court to enable that court to conduct a financial inquiry. (Section 65A (8) of the Act)
